Calling ALL Cub Scouts to build their own adventure at our Minecraft themed Day Camp!

Cubcraft begins Thursday, July 18th at 8:30 a.m. Check-in starts at 8:15 a.m. Bring your BSA Health Form 680-001 Parts A & B to registration. Also, remember to wear tennis shoes, since we will be hiking every day.

Who Can Attend: This camp is for all registered Cub Scouts & their siblings.

Half-Day & Full-Day Camper Options: - We are offering a Half Day Camper or Full Day Camper option. The camp fee includes lunch (all 3 days for full day campers & Saturday lunch only for ½ day campers), a t-shirt, a Day Camp water bottle, program supplies, a Lava Slushie on Saturday and a patch for each Camper.

- **Half Day Campers** – Half Day Campers attend camp from 8:30-12:30. Half Day Campers will not receive lunch on Thursday & Friday, but they will receive lunch on Saturday during family day. The cost for Half Day Campers is \$50. This is a great option for Lions & Tigers!
- **Full Day Campers** – Full Day Campers attend camp from 8:30-4:30. We will serve them lunch at all 3 days. The cost for Full Day Campers is \$60.
- **One Adult Volunteer per every one to five Scouts and siblings from each participating den or pack is required. Adult Volunteers do not have to pay to register.**
- **All Lion & Tiger Cubs must have an adult partner with them at all times.**

Cubcraft Fun - Once campers have registered, they will visit Crafting Tables to build their own swords, pickaxes or cardboard torches. They will use these items and build structures as part of Minecraft Games. The fun continues when campers build & race Creeper Bots. At Brewing Stations, they will brew Creeper Slime and other Minecraft potions. Campers will also participate in the following Cub Scout Adventures:

- **Lions** – Fun On The Run; Mountain Lion; Gizmos & Gadgets; Rumble In The Jungle
- **Tiger** - My Tiger Jungle; Games Tigers Play; Tiger Tag; Tiger Bites; Tigers In The Wild; Stories In Shape
- **Wolf** - Council Fire; Paws On The Path; Running With The Pack; Air Of The Wolf; Cubs Who Care; Finding Your Way
- **Bear** – Bear Claws; Baloo The Builder; Forensics; Robotics & Super Science
- **WEBELOS** - WEBELOS Walkabout; Adventures In Science; Build It and Build My Own Hero
- **AOL** - Camper (Outdoorsman); Req 1 of Scouting Adventure; Adventures In Science; Build It and Build My Own Hero

What to Bring Each Day:

- Fishing Poles on Saturday
- Tennis shoes – No Flip Flops or open toe shoes -> We will be hiking every day.
- Sunscreen
- Water Bottle and snack

Family Day - On Saturday, July 20th, we invite your family to accompany you to Cubcraft! This includes lunch at the Minecraft Inn! We may even have Creeper Juice to accompany your meal! Family fun includes Zombie Pigman BBs, Skeleton Warrior Archery, Blaze Sling Slots, Ender Dragon Rockets, Lava Slushies, Elder Guardian Angling and Minecraft Paracord.

Cost:

1. **\$60/Full Day Camper** – The camper fee includes lunch (all 3 days), a Day Camp t-shirt, a Day Camp water bottle, program supplies, a Lava Slushie on Saturday and a Day Camp patch.
2. **\$50/Half Day Camper** – The camper fee includes lunch (on Saturday only), a Day Camp t-shirt, a Day Camp water bottle, program supplies, a Lava Slushie on Saturday and a Day Camp patch.
3. **\$5/person for Family Day** - *the first adult accompanying their Scout is free.* If the rest of the family attends, they will need to pay a fee of \$5/person. This includes lunch and program supplies! This section only has to be completed once per family if you are completing multiple camper registration forms.
4. **Adults can order a Cub Scout Day Camp t-shirt (see the prices on the registration form).** Indicate name and size on the registration form

Early Registration & Registration Instructions:

1. Please send or bring the form on page 3 & your Scout's BSA Health Form 680-001 Parts A & B to the Tuscarora Council Service Center to register. Please complete one Registration form & one BSA Health form per camper. **Health forms cannot be sent electronically due to HIPAA regulations.**
2. Please complete a BSA Health Form 680-001 for anyone attending besides the camper. This includes adults & siblings.
3. **The Registration Deadline is Wednesday, July 3rd at 5 pm.** A \$10.00 late fee will be incurred for any registrations after this deadline & your scout will not be guaranteed a patch & T-Shirt.
4. Early registration will be available for this event -> details to follow in a Council-wide email blast.
5. We will email the list of Adventures that your Scout has completed to you & your Scout's Cubmaster **if** you provide good contact information.

Volunteers – Boy Scouts (First Class rank and 14 years of age or older), may volunteer to help staff Cub Scout Day Camp. These Scouts will receive service hours. Please contact Susan Lewis **before showing up at camp.**

Your Troops' Boy Scouts can volunteer to accompany your group as a Den Chief. These volunteers can go through their Scoutmaster & your Cubmaster for approval. Please let them know if they are coming as a Den Chief that they need to stay with their group the entire day.
